



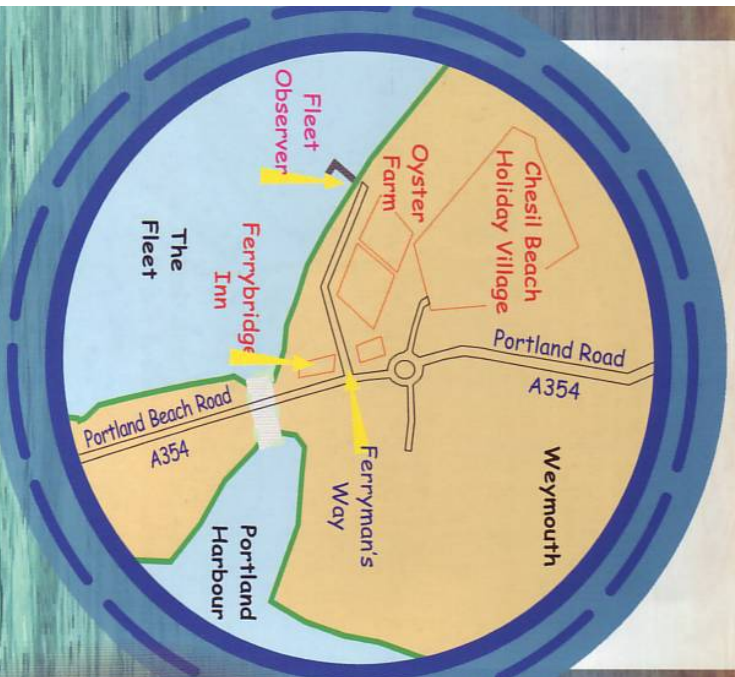

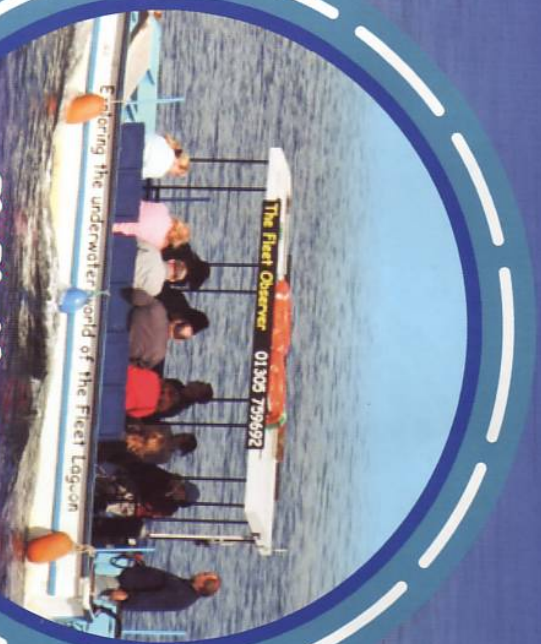

Hour long trips throughout the day.

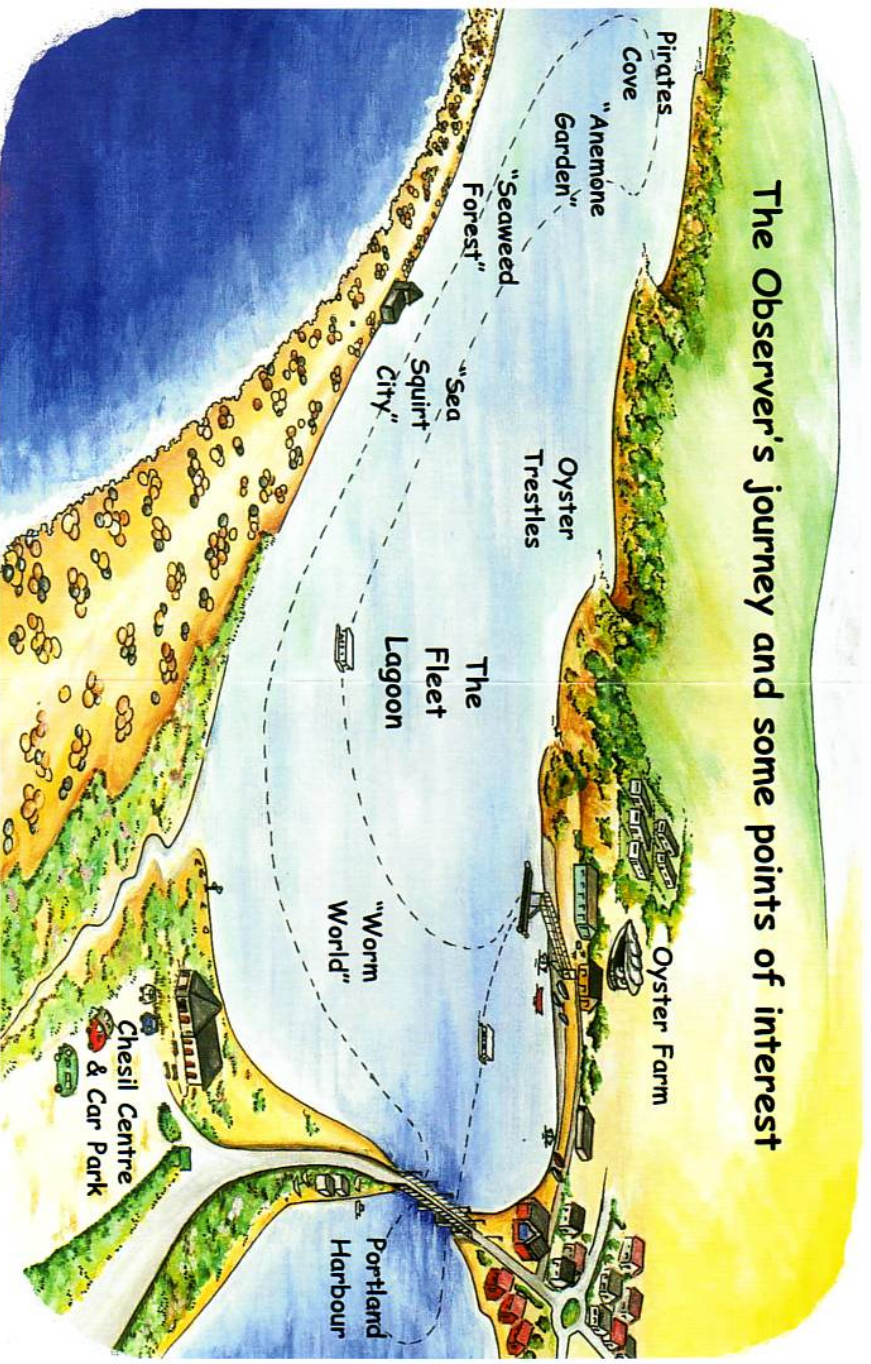
Adults £7, Children £4, under 3's free.
